Defining Homelessness Simply

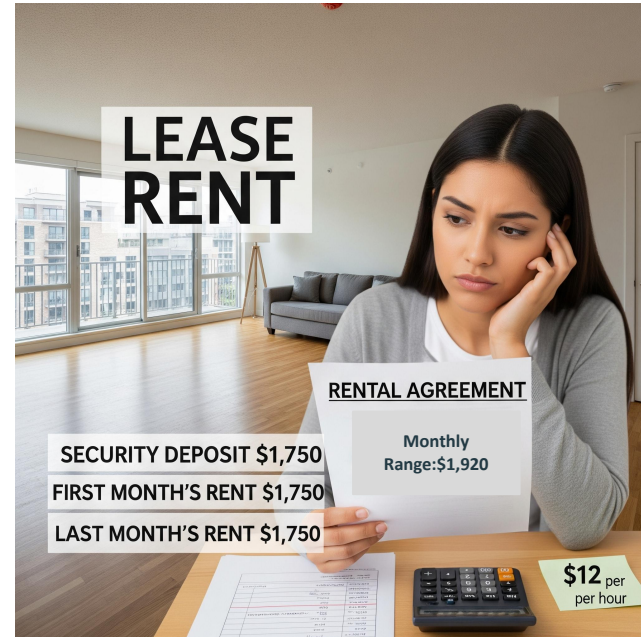


- Homelessness means lacking a stable, reliable daily residence
- People without a fixed residence sleep in shelters or unsuitable locations
- Poverty and lack of affordable housing contribute to homelessness
- Mental illness and Substance Abuse can lead to homelessness

Causes of Homelessness Explored



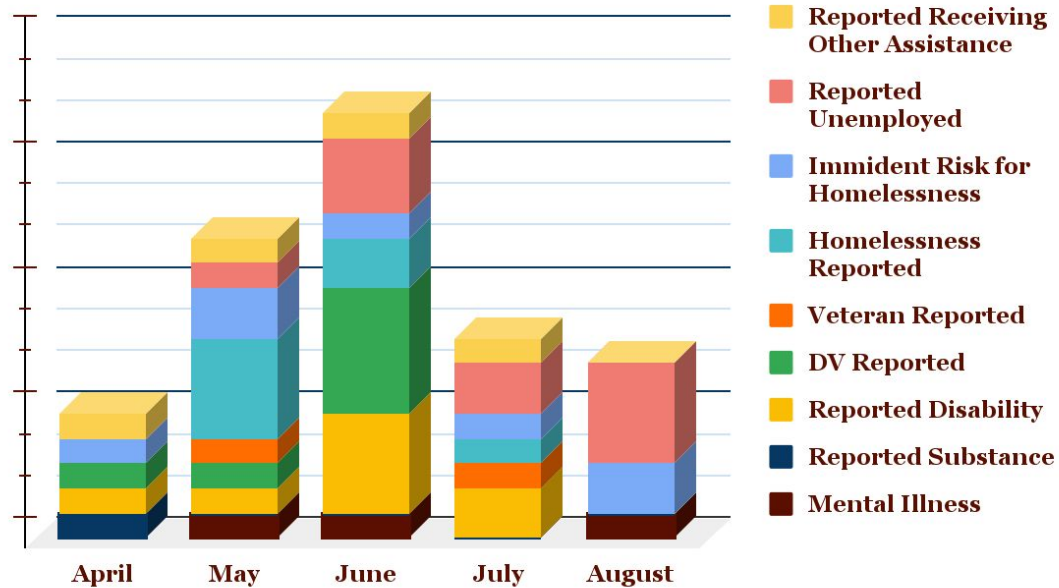
- Lack of affordable housing is a major root cause of homelessness
- Unemployment and unstable job situations can lead to losing housing
- Mental health issues significantly contribute to risk of becoming homeless
- Substance Abuse can cause difficulties maintaining housing stability
- Interpersonal conflicts may result in losing a safe living situation

1 — Homeless prevention assistance is critical for stability

3 — San Juan County focuses on supporting housing needs

Preventing Displacement



1 — Offering Rent, Application Fees, Security Deposits, and Utility assistance is crucial

2 — Payment support for up to four months is available yearly

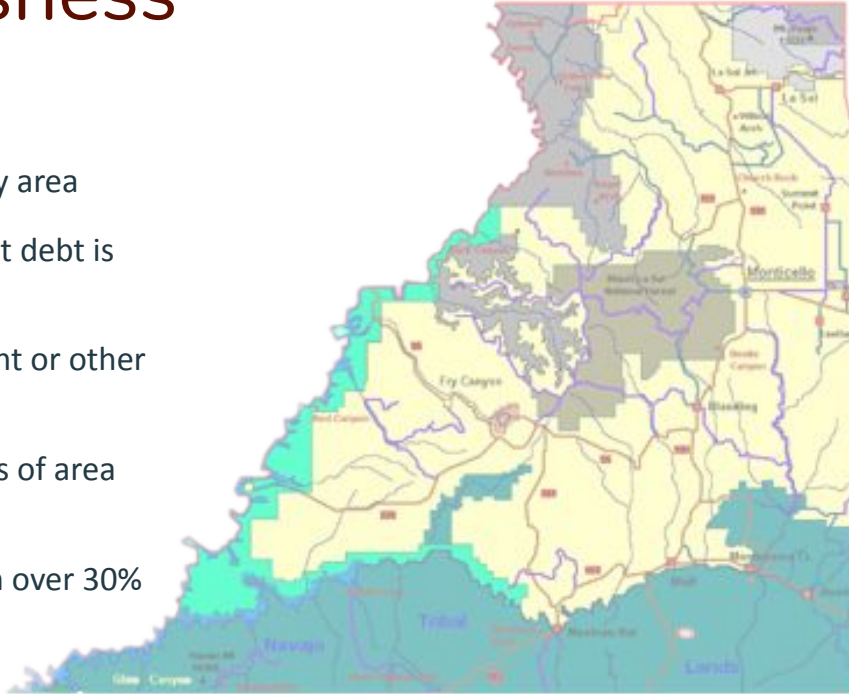
3 — Help with planning and maintaining budgets for financial stability

4 — Aid in resolving issues and problems that arise with landlords

Eligibility: Preventing Homelessness



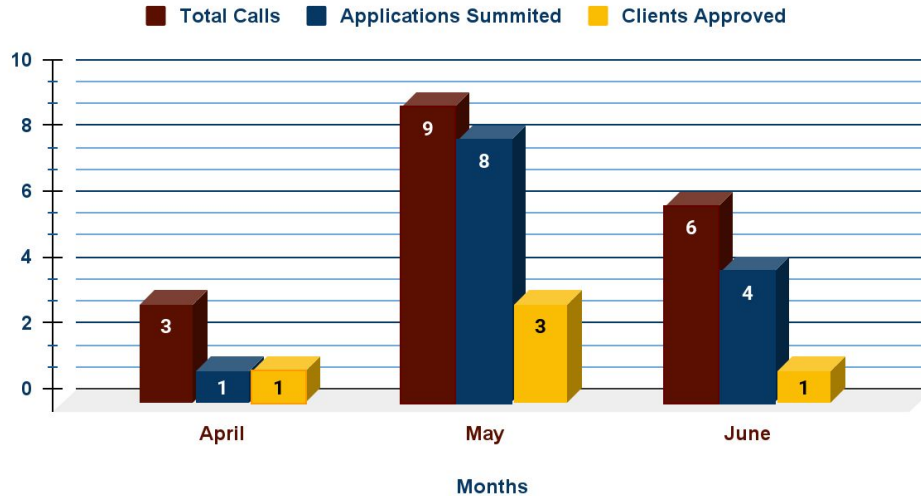
- Must reside within San Juan County area
- Involuntary housing loss due to rent debt is required
- Demonstrate attempts at repayment or other financial aid
- Clients' income must be 30% or less of area median income
- Potential eligibility discussions with over 30% AMI individuals



Navigating Prevention Assistance



Homeless Prevention Applications



- Submit the completed application form online or in person
- Provide supporting documents for income and residency
- Attend an interview to discuss your specific needs
- Wait for application review and eligibility determination

Community Partnerships Essential

- Partnerships strengthen community homelessness prevention efforts
- Local organizations collaborate for comprehensive support services
- Working together improves access to vital resources
- Coordinated efforts maximize positive impact on individuals
