RESOLUTION NO. 2019-02

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE RENEWAL TO DESIGNATE RESIDENTIAL,
COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL AREAS WITHIN SAN JUAN COUNTY AS AN
ENTERPRISE ZONE**

WHEREAS, the State of Utah has authority to establish Enterprise Zones within the jurisdictional boundaries of counties, as set forth by the "Enterprise Zone Act" (63N-2-201, *et seq.*, UCA 1953, as amended); and

WHEREAS, San Juan County is a body politic of the State of Utah, having a population of roughly 16,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone Act provides certain incentives and benefits for businesses qualifying for participation under the program; and

WHEREAS, designation of an Enterprise Zone does not amend, alter, modify, nor change the permitted uses of the land within San Juan County; and

WHEREAS, existing businesses within San Juan County could derive benefits from participation in a designated Enterprise Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Board of San Juan County Commissioners finds that participation in the Enterprise Zone program may enhance the County's ability to recruit and retain businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of San Juan County Commissioners finds that qualified businesses in all residential, commercial and industrial zones within the County may benefit from incentives available through the Enterprise Zone program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of San Juan County Commissioners as follows:

1. That the economic development efforts of San Juan County can be enhanced by participation in the Enterprise Zone program;
2. That San Juan County should renew the acquired designation of all residential, commercial and industrial zones of the County as an "Enterprise Zone".


