


How to Get There:
 Go south out of Blanding on Highway 191. After a few miles you will come to the junction with Highway 95 going to the west. Take 95 to mile post 115. Go north on County road 228, South Cottonwood, for approximately 1 mile to the junction with County road 240. Take 240 to the west. In approximately one mile you will see a staging area on your left. Unload here and see map for directions to the Arch Canyon, Hotel Rock and Texas Flat trails.

Alternate Route:
 Go south out of Blanding on Highway 191 for a few miles to the junction with Highway 95. Take 95 past mile post 107 to the junction with County road 235, South Comb Wash. Turn south on 235 and unload in the camping area just south of Highway 95. Head north and cross Highway 95 to County road 205, North Comb Wash. Follow 205 for approximately two miles to the vicinity of trails 39, 40 and 55. Refer to the map for details.
